1. Introduction

This notice to mariners is to inform that Moray Offshore Windfarm (West) Limited ("**Moray West**") will be commencing with the installation of earthing Clamps at the Moray West Offshore Wind Farm (Windfarm Marine License MS-000105085) from around 2nd August 2024. The work comprises of the installation of 3x earth clamps at each of the J tube cages at OSP 1 and OSP 2. The clamps will be installed using air divers by the vessel Woodstock 1.




Figure 1. Moray West Wind Farm Site

The Moray West wind farm site is located on the Smith Bank in the Outer Moray Firth, approximately 22.5km from the Caithness coastline, as shown in Figure 1.




Figure 2. Moray West wind farm site – Location of the works

The installation works are to take place within the red boundary shown in the figure below (Figure 2).

The installation works are anticipated to commence around 2nd August 2024 and are forecasted to be completed by 10th August 2024. The exact duration and completion date will depend on the weather and progress of the works.



2. Earth Clamp installation works

The scope of TP installation with Woodstock 1 comprises of the installation of 6x JTC earthing clamps in total split between the two locations

The installation will be carried out with the moored vessel Woodstock 1.

Please be aware that, during installation works, the Woodstock 1 will be moored to the boat landing fenders at OSP 1 and 2. Masters of vessels are requested to maintain their vessels and gears at a minimum safe passing distance from the vessel of 500 meters when it is undertaking work and showing the appropriate shapes and lights in accordance with COLREGs Rule 27 (International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea 1972, Rule 3).
